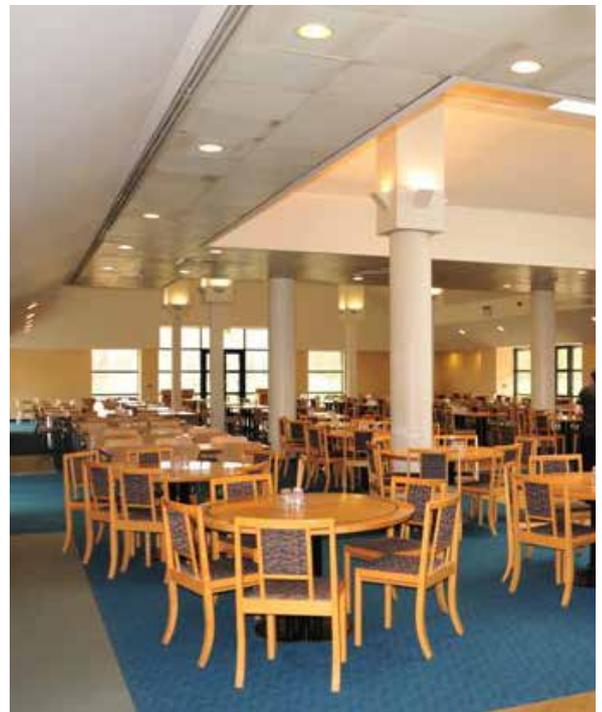

London (full day)

🕒 6-7hrs 📍 2hrs 30mins

London is one of the world's great capital cities and the largest city in the United Kingdom.

Excursion features: optional flight on the London Eye (if pre-booked) followed by walking tour to include Westminster Bridge, Trafalgar Square, Leicester Square and Covent Garden.

There will also be free time for shopping and more sightseeing.

Bath (full day)

🕒 6-7hrs 📍 2hrs

Bath is the largest city in Somerset and famous for its Roman Baths and the abbey which was founded in the 7th century.

Excursion features: a town trail including visit to the Roman Baths followed by packed lunch near the abbey. Resume town trail in the afternoon with time for shopping and sightseeing.

Oxford (half or full day)

🕒 2-7hrs 📍 1hr

Known as the city of dreaming spires Oxford is known throughout the world as a university city. Oxford University dates back to 1096, making it the oldest university in the English-speaking world.

Excursion features: a town trail including lunch by the river, followed by more sightseeing and shopping in the covered market.

Windsor Castle (half day)

🕒 1-3hrs 📍 1hr 30mins

Originally a wooden fortress built at the time of William the Conqueror, Windsor castle is the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world and one of the Queen's favorite homes.

Excursion features: tour of Windsor Castle plus free time for shopping.

Cambridge (full day)

🕒 6-7hrs 📍 3hrs 20mins

Cambridge is famous throughout the world as a university city. The university was founded in 1209 and is the second oldest in the English-speaking world. The university comprises 31 colleges including the world-famous King's College with its chapel and choir.

Excursion features: visit to King's College followed by a walking tour of the city and lunch in Christ's Pieces park. There will be time in the afternoon for shopping at the Grafton Centre.

Plymouth (full day)

🕒 6-7hrs 📍 3hrs

Plymouth is famous as a port, the place where Sir Francis Drake played bowls before meeting the Spanish Armada, and the point of departure for the Pilgrim Fathers on their journey to America in 1620.

Excursion features: town trail, including Plymouth Hoe, Smeaton's Tower, barbican and old town, Mayflower Steps Memorial and Elizabethan garden.

There will also be free time for shopping and more sightseeing.

Bristol (full day)

🕒 6-7hrs 📍 1hr

Bristol is a city spanning the River Avon in the southwest of England with a prosperous maritime history.

Excursion features: A visit to Brunel's SS Great Britain or We The Curious in the morning followed by lunch, a town trail and free time for shopping in the city centre.

Stratford upon Avon (full day)

🕒 6-7hrs 📍 1hr 30mins

Stratford upon Avon is famous as the birthplace of William Shakespeare, regarded by many as the greatest playwright of all time.

Excursion features: a town trail including visit to the Shakespeare birthplace museum, packed lunch by the river and time for shopping in the afternoon.

Lost Property

All personal items should be clearly named. We strongly recommend that all valuables are left at home.

- Tops & jackets**

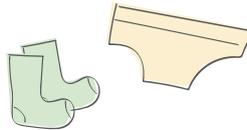
Your arms will need to be covered to do some activities.

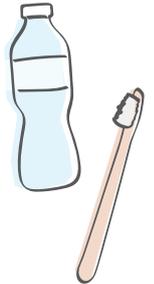
