LOCATION & CAMPUS

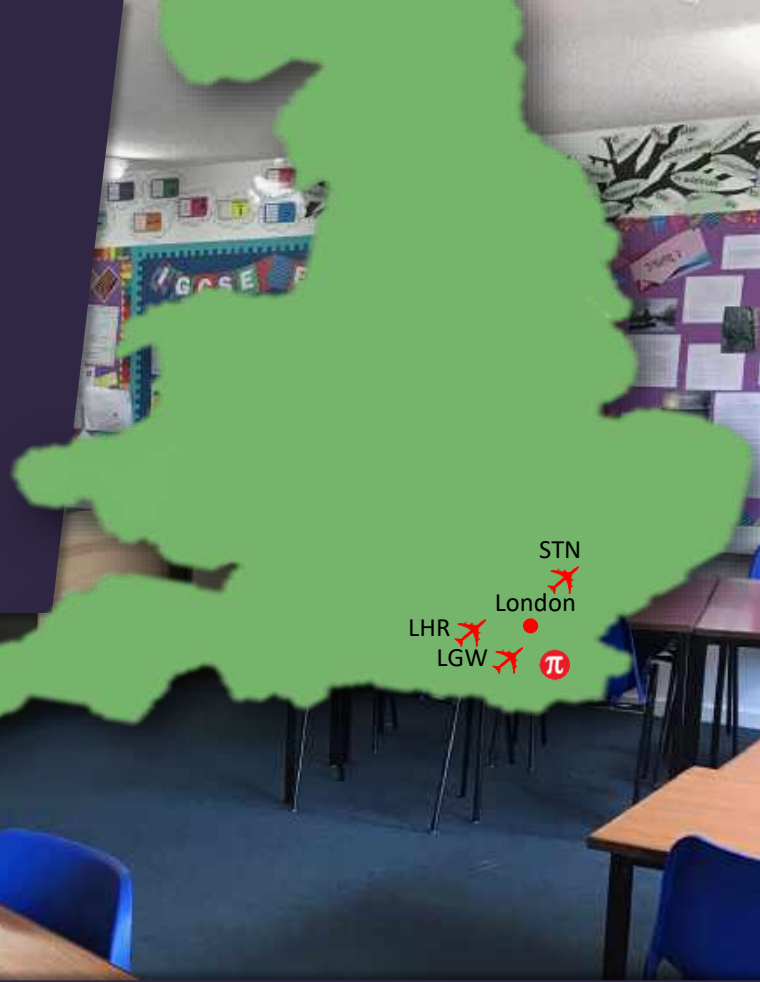
Founded by the Reverend Joseph Kendon in 1866.

Co-educational day and boarding school set on a rural campus in the heart of the stunning Kent country side. Occupying some 60 acres of the Weald, a truly enviable site.

Situated about 1 hour south of London between Tunbridge Wells and Ashford and is easily accessible from all the London airports.

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FACILITIES & ACCOMMODATION

- π Facilities at this picturesque campus includes state of the art sports equipment, a brand new indoor swimming pool and imaginative outdoor classrooms.
- π Accommodation in the school is split across 5 boarding houses. Rooms vary but consist mainly of singles to rooms of 5 beds. All boarding houses are well furnished with kitchens and large common room areas.
- π A bespoke laundry service is provided by the school once a week.
- π On arrival, a damage deposit of £30 will be collected. This will be returned to students at the end of the course should they not be responsible for any damage.





ENGLISH CLASSES

On the day following arrival, there will be an English Placement Test to place the students into a suitable class. The students then have 12 hours of English lessons per week, with an emphasis on interaction and conversation. At the end of the course, a certificate is awarded to each student.

A TYPICAL TEACHING DAY

16:00-17:10: The teacher introduces a new grammatical structure or language function to the class, which is then reinforced either through a written or spoken activity. This may often include role-play situations.

17:10-17:15: Break

17:15-18:30: The focus here is to get students to work together on a project. By setting an interesting task, we feel it encourages students to communicate and is also more enjoyable.

A TYPICAL TEACHING DAY

For those not wanting to take English lessons, **multi activity sessions** are offered. These may include badminton, swimming, volleyball, table tennis or dodgeball.

EVENING ACTIVITIES

In the evening, there will be discos, film shows sports & games, barbecue, talent shows and much more to enjoy. All activities are supervised by our own residential staff.

MATCHES (Programme Permitting)

Tennis players may visit the LTA's (Lawn Tennis Association) National Centre at Roehampton and play against academy students. Football students may get to compete against local teams.

EXCURSIONS

Full Day Excursion Options include: Wimbledon, Chelsea FC Stadium Tour, Thames River Cruise or British Museum.
